Cookie Duration

- Persistent cookies: These cookies store data on the user's device and can be
 accessed and processed for a period defined by the cookie's controller. This period
 may range from a few minutes to several years.

To check the duration of cookies installed on your device, you can use your browser's developer tools. To do this, right-click anywhere on the webpage and select "Inspect". A new window or split screen will appear. In the "Storage" section (or "Application – Storage"), you can view detailed information about the cookies stored, including their expiry date and duration.
